They decided to raise the bus fare 10 cents and the majority of the people who are living on \$300-\$500 dollars a month; they already pay over \$100 dollars a month for a monthly bus pass, had enough. They rose up and said we will not take it anymore. Initially the police and politicians called them thugs and treated them as such with a very heavy hand. When the people refused to back down and continued their peaceful protests; the politicians had to ask for them to be treated with respect. While some acted like knuckleheads, most were only exercising their right to protest and did so in an organized manner. Our partner Novidade church also sent our protestors. Their message was a little different than most. Their signs read "Ore Pelo Brasil" and "Deus e aquele quem muda as coisas", translation, Pray for Brazil and God is the one who changes things. Many others joined this call for real change and I hope the fever is catching.



The governments did eventually roll back the fare increase, but still have only made promises to further change. But God is good and the work is still going strong. Our partners are busier than ever maintaining and building works. Ana Paula has been rebuilding her work since releasing her

position as pastor. She is emphasizing on evangelism and doing children's works with other local ministries. She and Sandra are in 5 communities doing mostly open air events.
